

More to Life Family Campground Guidelines

To maintain a restful and safe vacation spot we are establishing some guidelines to help accomplish this. Thank you for your thoughtful compliance and consideration. Although we like to think that good old common sense would prevail here at More to Life Family Campground, we know that the posting of basic guidelines for everyone helps to see that you stay here with us will be one of rest, relaxation, safety, and spiritual refreshment. Please be sure that each member of your family knows and abides by them. Thank you!!

1. More to Life Family Campground is privately owned. We reserve the right to select our clientele and guests. Those not meeting the standard of dress or conduct will be asked to leave without any refund. The management has full authority over the campground and its facilities, including enforcement of the Guidelines.
2. All guests please register at the Camp Store.
3. Check in time is 2:00pm / Check out time is 11:00am
4. The speed limit is 10 M.P.H. Please drive cautiously and always watch out for children.
5. Campsites/cabins/trailers are to always be kept neat and clean, especially upon check out. Trash is to be disposed of in the dumpster located in the lower parking lot by the store. We require a credit card on file on all cabins for damage, smoking, etc. Your card will be charged if any damage occurs while you stay.
6. Anyone under the age of 18 must have a parent or legal guardian in the park at all times.
Parents:
please know where your child is always. You are responsible for your child and your visiting child's behavior.
7. Quiet time is between the hours of 10:00pm and 8:00am.
8. All children under the age of 18 must be on your campsite at 10:00pm
9. Campfires are to be kept low and under strict supervision of a responsible adult.
10. Pets are welcome at More to Life Family Campground must always be leashed. All dogs and cats must have a valid rabies certificate available upon request. At no time will pets be allowed at the pond.
11. Gray water may not be dumped on your site, please use the outside sinks located at the bathhouses.
12. All fees are due at the time of registration. Refunds will not be made for shortened stays or cancellations or weather.
13. Please be considerate of fellow campers and limit showers to five minutes. Children under the age of 9 are not to use the bathhouse or Balat center bathrooms unattended.
14. All people using More to Life Family Campground facilities do so at their own risk and they assume full responsibility for injury or illness occurring while on its grounds or in its facilities.
15. This is a drug, and alcohol-free campground. Use of these substances is always prohibited on campground property. If we see you smoking on site, you will be asked to leave without refund. Smoking is only permitted at the designated smoking area. Please see management for this information.
16. Only two vehicles allowed per site. Motorcycles, minibikes, and mopeds are permitted as transportation in and out of the campgrounds only. No four wheelers are allowed. Bicycles are permitted on the road but are prohibited after dusk.

17. It is recommended for children under 16 to wear a helmet at their parents' discretion.
 18. Please do not remove picnic tables from any site without permission.

17. Any use of firearms, fireworks, or stone throwing is prohibited.
 18. All clothing must be worn while in the campground. Men must keep shirts on unless they are at the beach.
 19. Golf carts are admitted. Must have a valid driver's license to operate and insurance.
 20. Building projects are not allowed on Friday through Sunday and any other building projects during the week need to be preauthorized.
 21. Pump-outs need to be marked on the board.
 22. DUMPSTER: HOUSEHOLD TRASH ONLY!!! FROM YOUR CAMPER NOT YOUR HOUSE!!! No metal, plastic totes, boxes, etc.
 23. All access to and from campground must be accessed from Lady Slipper Ln not Boot Cove Ln (Back gate)
 24. All guests must register at the store.
 25. All canoes and watercraft must be chained and locked if left at the beach. On the Waterfront Our major concern in and around Lower Narrows Pond is safety.

By following the few guidelines below, you can help us in this endeavor. The following guidelines are to be adhered to by everyone, adults as well as children. Parking at the beach is limited. If possible, please walk to the beach. There is one parking lot as you come down the hill on the left and another past the beach on left. Parking on the road is not allowed.

1. Children under the age of 14 must be accompanied by a responsible adult while at the beach over the age of 18.
2. Appropriate swimwear for women, with a cover-up while walking around the campground or to and from the beach men are to wear a shirt while in the campground.
3. Boats and kayaks are available for rent on a first come, first served basis. Please be sensitive to those who are waiting for their turn.
4. All persons in any type of watercraft, camp owned or privately owned, must have a secure life jacket on and remain seated at all times. There are no exceptions.
5. Dogs are not allowed on the beach or in the pond at any time.
6. There is NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY at the pond at any time, please keep a close watch on your children. IN ALL CASES, PARENTS' YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR YOUR CHILDREN. With your full cooperation, and that of those you are responsible for, we are certain that this place God has given us to enjoy, More to Life Family Campground, will remain the spirit-filled, holy place that it is, for many others to come, share and enjoy. Laundry Facilities are located at the ends of each bathhouse. \$1.75 per washer/per dryer. These areas are not for children to play in.
